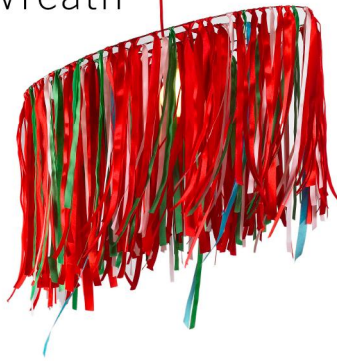


The Project Wreath



Projekt Wiecha

The Wreath Project is inspired by an old Polish tradition to hang wreath on the top of roof as a sign of completing construction, and at the same time a symbol of joy and feast.

The Lamp consists of 60 cm diameter spiral wire and approx. 120 knots of silk ribbon.

The Wreath Project is unique yet functional object full of possibilities – it's final style and look depends on the user who can choose colors and materials.

The main objective of the designer was to design simple product for every household with no limits in shape except our imagination.

“I wish that my Wreath would be an inexpensive gift for all those who finished redecoration – symbol of joy and good luck.

Depending on needs and imagination of its owner Wreath can change color and length. It is possible to hang small decorations or other objects on it. Design invites to interaction” explains Agnieszka Lasota.

The Wreath Project lamp is made of a 60 cm diameter wire spiral construction. The decorative unit consists of more than 120 knots of a silk ribbon with an overall length of more than 130 meters. Total weight approx 600 g. Length approx 30 – 50 cm. Fits to standard lamp socket. Max

60 W bulb. Energy saving bulbs are recommended.

The Project Wreath is a handmade lampshade, so small imperfections and differences in size are possible. Each product is a unique object of art.



Agnieszka Lasota graduated from the interior architecture class at the Warsaw Academy of Fine Arts, and advanced studies of interior architecture at the Istituto Europeo di Design in Milan, Italy. From the graduation on she works as an interior architect. Author of unique furniture and works from the border of conceptual art and design. Lately she is experimenting in her creativity with the “work with process”.
